Savers Do Not Accept List

Must be posted at CDC, ADS, Savers and NPP Partners, and provided to all truck drivers

<p>WEAPONS Firearms, explosives, ammunition, flares, etc</p> <p>HAZARDOUS MATERIALS Batteries, paints, chemicals, cleaning products, poisons, any liquids, etc</p> <p>CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS Lumber, pipes, floors, tubs, cabinets, carpet, doors, windows, etc... <i>Note: some items in this category may be sellable (i.e., faucets, light fixtures, stained glass windows, hardware, decorative items)</i></p> <p>FLAMMABLE PRODUCTS Any items that operate on or contain fuel including: Gas cans, propane cylinders, barbecues, lawn mowers, weed trimmers, camp stoves, tiki torches, etc... <i>Note: even if items do not have fuel or a gas tank we do not accept them</i></p> <p>AUTOMOBILE PARTS Tires, mufflers, fenders, etc... <i>Note: some items in this category may be sellable (i.e., car radios, small parts)</i></p> <p>DAMAGED FURNITURE Torn, soiled or in need of repair. <i>Note: BC and SK provinces - no cloth or upholstered furniture.</i></p>	<p>BEDS and BEDDING PARTS Hide-a-beds, bunk beds, mattresses, box springs, waterbeds, coil springs, etc</p> <p>TELEVISIONS and COMPUTER MONITORS Large televisions in cabinets, CRT “tube” televisions and monitors. <i>Note: does not apply to LCD, LED or plasma flat screens.</i></p> <p>INFANT PRODUCTS Car seats, cribs and products restricted by law</p> <p>SWING SETS</p> <p>FOOD</p> <p>PETS</p> <p>LARGE APPLIANCES Refrigerators, dishwashers, furnaces, stoves, washing machines, etc</p> <p>MARINE VESSELS Boats, canoes, kayaks, etc</p> <p>SWIMMING POOLS Small (kid’s) plastic pools are acceptable</p>

CDC attendants and Drivers have the right to politely refuse obviously unacceptable items but not spend time searching through donations.

Consideration for the donor should be balanced with TM safety and store safety. (Examples: heavy items and chemicals could result in a TM injury, products containing fuel or vapor would be a fire hazard, the size or content of an item would impact disposal)
